DAY 1: PENANG - TRANSIT (MOB)

 Departure flight from Penang international airport to Melbourne

DAY 2: TRANSIT - MELBOURNE

DAY 3: MELBOURNE - MORNINGTON PENINSULA - MELBOURNE (B)

(Drive time: 3hrs 40mins)

• Depart to Mornington Peninsula

- First stop at **Brighton Bathing Boxes** Dive into Port Phillip Bay under the watch of 82 distinctive bathing boxes, a row of uniformly proportioned wooden structures lining the foreshore at Brighton Beach.
- Then visit **Enchanted Adventures** From the epic Tube Slides to the Tree Surfing courses, giant brainteaser puzzles, Canopy Walk, Sky Scramble and more, there is adventure for adults and kids alike!
- Continue visit **Cape Schanck Light House** One of the oldest lighthouses in Victoria, built all the way back in 1859. Climb the stone steps to the lamp room and look out over the blue waters of Bass Strait from the balcony. Look out for whales during migration season.
- On the way back Melbourne hotel, visit Rye Beach, Sorrento and Portsea
 Coastal views, rocky reefs offshore, sand beach walking, quiet bays and lookout views.

DAY 4: MELBOURNE - WARRNAMBOOL (B)

(Drive time: 4hrs)

- Check-out Melbourne Hotel
- Beginning today journey to Warrnambool, via Geelong.
- Continue to Great Ocean Road Experience the rugged beauty along the south-west coast of Victoria by setting off along one of the world's most scenic coastal drives.
- Arrive Port Campbell and visit 12 Apostles View the 12 Apostles at sunrise
 and sunset as they change from a brilliant sandy yellow colour under a full
 sun to appearing dark and foreboding in shadow.
- Next, check into your accommodation at Mid City Motel Warrnambool. In the evening, visit Flagstaff Hill Maritime Museum and Village to enjoy the Tales of the Shipwreck Coast Sound & Light Show with engaging stories of local Aboriginals and colourful whaling history.

DAY 5: WARRNAMBOOL - PORTLAND - ROBE (B)

(Drive time: 4hrs 30mins)

- After Check-out, depart to **Robe**, via **Port Fairy**.
- You may visit Flagstaff Hills Maritime Museum and Village if time permit.
- Continue to **Portland** Delve into history and get back to nature in this thriving city by the sea. Wander streets dotted with beautifully maintained heritage buildings and dine on great pub fare while overlooking the harbour.





- Visit Petrified Forest , The Blow Hole & Cape Bridgewater
- You may stopover **Umpherston Sinkhole** Appreciate its size and depth from the viewing platforms at the top of the sinkhole, then walk down into the sinkhole, along the terraces and behind the hanging vines.
- Next check into your accommodation.

DAY 6: ROBE - VICTOR HARBOUR - ADELAIDE

(Drive time: 5hrs)

Then, you'll head inland and around Lake Alexandrina towards **Victor Harbor** - Victor Harbor is the main town on the Fleurieu Peninsula and a vibrant holiday destination. Located on Encounter Bay, it has some pretty impressive coastal properties and stunning views across the ocean.
- A short drive north of there and you'll finally be in **Adelaide!** Adelaide is an underrated city, with beautiful beaches, waterfalls, gardens, and vineyards all within a short drive from the CBD.

Settled in 1839 by Prussian Lutherans seeking religious freedom, Hahndorf is now an artisan village and a delight for shoppers.

DAY 8: ADELAIDE (B)
